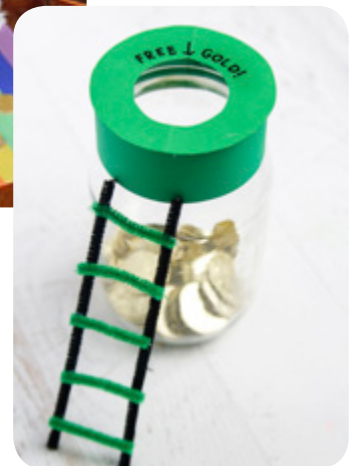
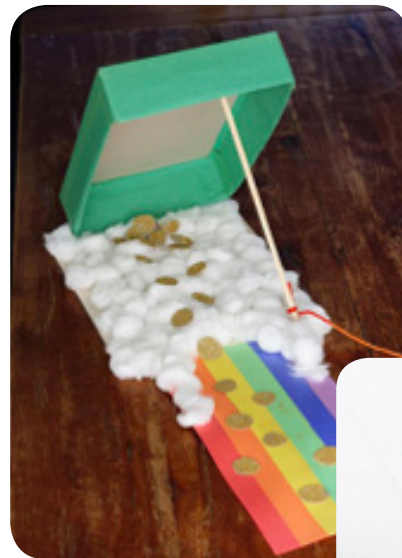

What to Do:

1. Gather the items you will need for your trap. (List of materials and examples below.)
2. Build your trap. Get creative! There is a list of suggested materials below.
3. Find a good spot to set up the trap.
4. Wait for the leprechaun to arrive!

Things you will need:

- Shoe / tissue / cereal box
- Glass or plastic jar
- Lego / duplos
- Construction paper or paint
- Sticks
- String
- Glue
- Hot glue (With parent help!)
- Something gold or shiny (to trick the leprechaun)
- Decorations - get creative!



Tips to Build the Perfect Trap:

- A bait of some sort: charms, pennies, or fake gold can be your bait for the leprechaun!
- A ladder: you can build a ladder with pipe cleaners, popsicle sticks, twigs or even Legos!
- Some trapping mechanism: you can trap your leprechaun with a hole (like our jars), a gate that closes or something that falls on top of the leprechaun.
