## Introduction

For today's craft we are going to be making Miss Cuttle from our story time *Rainbow Fish & Friends Lost at Sea*. For a math exercise, have the child count with you as they create the legs and sucker for the octopus.

### Things you will need:

- Construction paper
- Cupcake liners
- Cheerios
- Scissors
- Glue
- Marker/Crayons
- Pencils



## What to Do:

1. Have your child pick a full sheet of construction paper, and explain that this is the sea where your octopus lives.
2. Have them pick another color for the octopus tentacles, and a cupcake liner for the octopus body.
3. Have them pick a spot on the construction paper for the sea, where they want the octopus body to be. Trace cupcake liner on the paper.
4. Take the color construction paper they have picked for the octopus tentacles, and help your child cut eight strips. Have them count with you and glue them onto the paper where you have traced the cupcake liner.
5. Glue down the cupcake liner and have them draw their octopus face.
6. Lastly, have your child glue cheerios on the tentacles to represent the suckers. Let them add as many as they want, and count with them!
