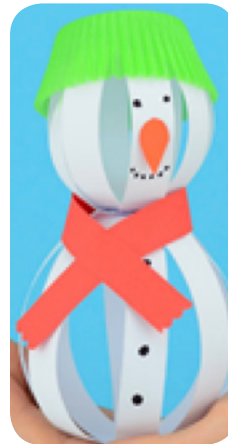

Things you will need:

- 5 short white strips of paper
- 5 long white strips of paper
- 1 piece of colored paper
- 1 cupcake liner
- Black & orange markers
- 3 brass brads, or stapler
- Glue



What to Do:

Step 1: Punch a hole on both ends of all the strips of white paper (both long and short).

Step 2: Stack all 5 short sized paper strips together and fasten the brass brad through each end. Repeat this step for the 5 long sized paper strips.

Step 3: Gently bend the stack of papers and separate each strip to form a sphere. You should end up with one small sphere for the snowman's head, and one large sphere for the snowman's body

Step 4: With a small dot of glue, secure the snowman's head to the snowman's body.

Step 5: Using your markers, color in your snowman's nose, eyes, and buttons. Use your colored paper to make your snowman a scarf, and a cupcake liner for the hat.
